Bradley Village Hall 911 Call Center Renovation

Project Highlights and Results

- Initial Capital Plan reviewed the condition of the existing building MEP systems and made prioritized recommendations to meet the emergency functions of the building and support the local community.
- Capital plan evaluated options to both renovate the existing building (including identifying the minimum requirements) in phases or abandon it and construct an entirely new facility.
- Upgraded the building's existing electrical service and installed a new back-up generator, UPS, dedicated HVAC system, and inert gas fire suppression system for the 911 Call Center and associated data center as a priority project.
